Dear Parents and Carers,

As some of you may have seen on ITV and BBC news my husband as the Head teacher at Hotspur primary school was subjected last week to some hurtful and libellous graffiti that appeared around the school on pavements, signs and houses facing the school. This was obviously very distressing but the support and love shown on Facebook and at the school has been quite overwhelming. The children and parents at Hotspur have rallied and categorically stated that their school is a safe place for everyone and such behaviour and attitudes have no place in their school where children grow and learn.

This is critical for us at West Jesmond too. I often call us the United Nations of Schools and together we learn and grow harmoniously together. Within the Ouseburn Learning Trust we want to ensure you that we will not tolerate behaviour like this in any of our schools and we want all of our parents to know that they are valued and recognised for who they are. Sadly, I feel we are living through a difficult time where political governance and ethical, dignified leadership is sadly



lacking and not representative of the behaviour we expect from those that dedicate their life to public service. It is inevitable that this would spill out eventually into changing what some people feel is acceptable behaviour.

Miles was very clear in his newsletter (available to read on the Hotspur website and also on Facebook) to his parents that sadly many people experience some form of hate crime on a regular basis based on their race, religion, gender and sexual orientation. It is our duty to educate our pupils and show them a better way to live together and respect and value our differences.


