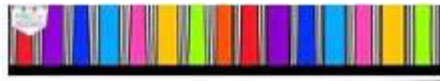

If you have a printer you can print out the word search on the next page to complete.



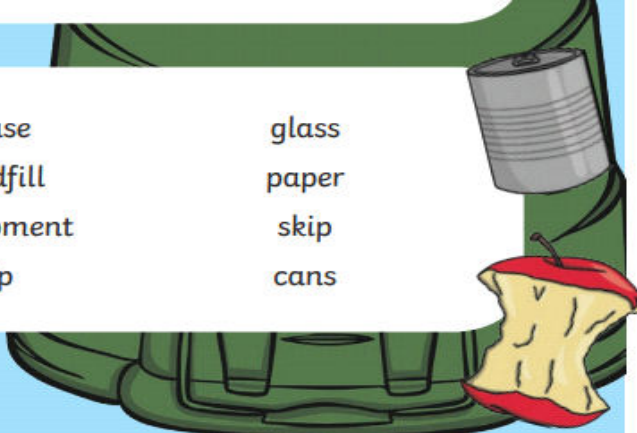
