There was a lot yellow to be seen in school today as we marked World Mental Health Day. Assemblies and class talks have been focusing on the importance of trying to look after our mental health as well as our physical health. We talked about how some of our regular routines can help us. These might include playing with friends, being outside in nature, healthy sleep patterns, singing, reading, and relaxing. However, we also talked about how sometimes it is also very important to talk to trusted adults at home or at school about our feelings. Our Zones of Regulation approach is one of the ways that we support children to identify how they are feeling. The zones, hopefully, help them to recognise and talk openly about their emotions and explore ways that, together, we can try to address them. 
Our WJPS Hockey Team In Action
