- ✓ Button for nose
- √ Felt fabric in red, white and brown for mouth, whites of eyes, tongue and ears

✓ Suitably coloured sock

- √ Two googly eyes
- ✓ Sewing needle and matching threads
- √ Scissors
- √ Glue
- ✓ An adult to help you

METHOD

Read through the instructions carefully and gather all of the materials needed before you start.



Start by creating the shape of your sausage dog's face, put your hand inside the sock and hold it like in the photo. This will help you to plan the size and positioning of its mouth, lolling tongue and ears.



Cut out a mouth, tongue and ears from felt.













Carefully position the dog's mouth, see positioning in photo. Securely stitch into place using a matching coloured thread.




Now stitch in the dog's lolling tongue. Position it so that it hangs out even when the dog's mouth is closed.



Carefully position the dog's ears on top of its head. Secure with pins. Securely stitch into place using matching coloured thread.



Carefully cut out two white circles for the dog's eyes.



Stick your dog's googly eyes on to the white eye circles Most have a sticky back, but if not use some glue.

Pin and then stitch them in place onto your dog's face.



Securely stitch on the button nose, right at the end of the toe part of your sock.

Name your new dog. Ours is called Freddie.
