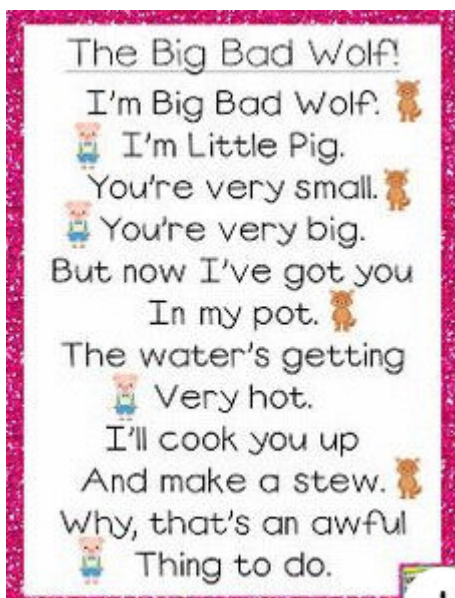

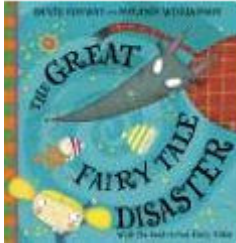


Wednesday
