

HUMANITIES

Our first topic this term is Incredible Inventors where we will explore inventors and their inventions. We will be answering our big question, 'Who is the most significant inventor?' using our historical enquiry skills to research and compare four inventors.



MATHS

We will be introducing the concept of multiplication and division and learning our 2, 5 and 10 times tables. We will build on our knowledge of making equal groups from Year 1 and link this concept to multiplication, using language such as '2 groups of 5 is 10'. We will then move on to looking at money before Christmas.



SCIENCE

This half-term we investigate 'sound' and explore the work of Alexander Graham-Bell to complement our 'Incredible Inventors' topic. We will continue to develop our 'Working Scientifically' investigation skills by designing and conducting our own experiments. Our big question is, 'How are sounds made?'



ENGLISH

In English this half term we will be reading the story 'The Lost Thing' by Shaun Tan, focusing on developing our inference and prediction skills. We will also be reading, 'Rosie Revere, Engineer' by Andrea Beaty and working on our creative writing. As always we will continue to focus on sentence rules, handwriting and sentence structure.
