Dear Parents and Carers,

Home-Schooling Arrangements

As many parents will be aware we were initially given very little notice of the enforced closure of schools back in March (2 days actually).

In the interim period of lock-down we have put together a range of resources for children to work through online via the school website with a special section for each year group. I can assure parents that all staff that are not ill, including those having to shield at home for a minimum of 12 weeks, have been working very hard to try and keep education, support and contact with families going as best we can under these very difficult circumstances. This includes running the emergency child care for key workers.

I have become aware that there is considerable anxiety on 'WhatsApp groups' amongst the Year 5 parents about further educational support to help prepare children for entrance exams to our local independent schools and preparation for Year 6 and possible SATs in September.

We are currently working with the LA, Trade Unions and a specialist governor group on the logistics of what might happen should schools be allowed to return from June if the medical data allows it; though following information released today this is beginning to look more and more unlikely, especially within this region.

Should we be unable to open in the Summer Term we will look again at our online provision and see what we might be able to offer. At this stage, I cannot offer any other support due to staffing capacity. Parents should also be aware that the government guidance makes it very clear that if we are able to open, all staff will be needed to physically support any year groups returning and any online provision will only be dealt with by staff unable to be on site.
