Online Platforms

To share learning between home and school we use Tapestry in Reception and Seesaw for Years 1 and 6. Work will be shared and commented on by your child's class teacher(s) as well as members of the year group staff and occasionally the Senior Leadership Team. We work with the children on how to use the platforms in school but if you ever need support with anything please let the teachers know.
