To understand the United Kingdom is an island made up of four countries.

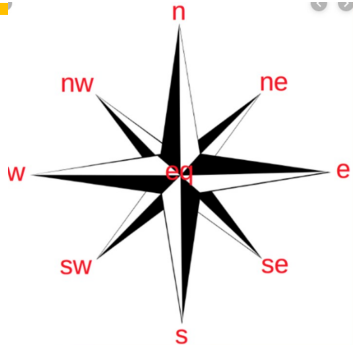
To locate the cardinal directions on a compass.
