As you know, we have a long and strong tradition of singing at West Jesmond. We are so famous for it, that Ian Roberts (Cathedral Director of Music) likes to visit to hear us sing, and search for the next generation of Newcastle Cathedral Choristers. The unique musical education enjoyed by Newcastle Cathedral Choristers is completely free of charge. Benefits include regular ensemble work with the Cathedral's professional musicians, individual lessons with a Vocal Coach, and lessons in musical theory. Other opportunities include national and international concert tours, BBC broadcasts, and professional CD recordings.

Boys and girls rehearse after school on a couple of days of the week (girls - Monday & Wednesday, boys - Tuesday & Thursday). There is the possibility of reinstating transport from Jesmond schools if a number are interested, or parental lift sharing is another option. Parents are invited to contact Ian Roberts - the Cathedral's Director of Music to find out more information and organise an audition or taster session for their child. Boys and girls usually begin in Years 3, 4 or 5, but in occasional circumstances applications for Year 6 children will also be considered.

New for this term is a group for Year 2 children called *ChoriStarters*. Just an hour a week of fun musical games and songs. There is no audition for this, and you can simply register by contacting the Cathedral Music Department. A number spaces remain available for this year, and parents of Year 1's can register for September 2020.
