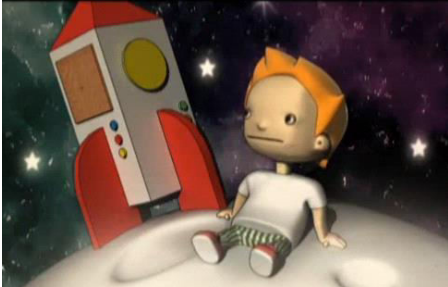

Can you describe the boy?

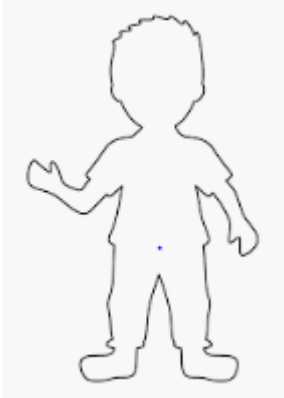
What does he look like?

How is he feeling?

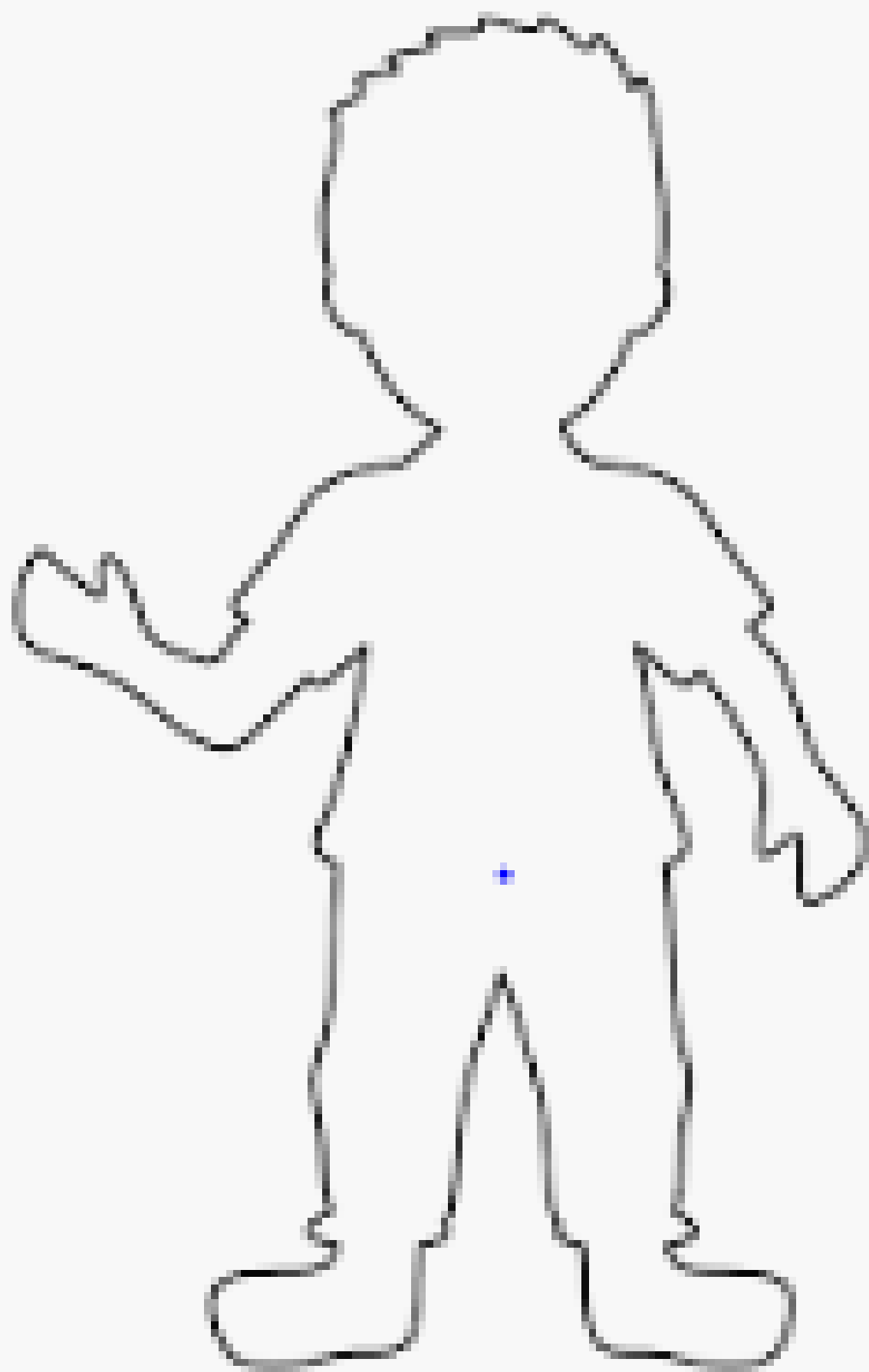
Write adjectives to describe what he looks like around the outside of his body.

The wolf huffed and puffed but could not blow down the house of bricks

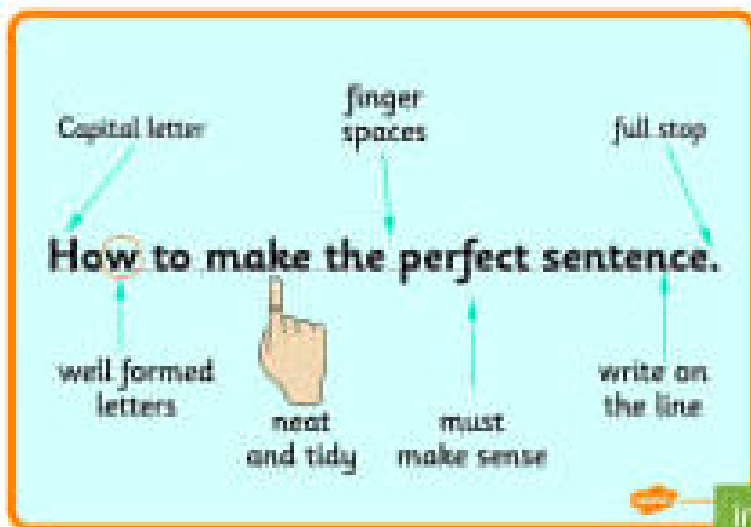
Thursday
